
#### DIY Mudroom in an Armoire



#### Materials:

- -1 full sheet 3/4" plywood
- -1 half sheet 3/4" plywood
- -2 full sheet 1/4" plywood
- -1 1x8x8
- -ll lx4x8 (I used furring strips to get the old worn look...but it takes a lot of digging to come by straight ones)
- -2 lx3x8 (I used furring strips)
- -4 lx2x8 (I used furring strips)
- -1 stick of crown molding
- -Kreg Jig
- -Saw
- -brad nailer
- -1 1/4" screws
- -l 1/4" brad nails
- -wood glue


#### Cut List:

Make sure that you measure if you don't use furring strips as it will slightly adjust some lengths of boards!! Your plywood should not be affected though!


- 2 pieces of 3/4" plywood ripped down to 16" x 84"
- 1 3/4" piece of plywood ripped down to 16" x 48"
- 1 3/4" piece of plywood ripped down to 16"x 46 1/2"
- 2 3/4" pieces of plywood ripped down to 14" x 46 1/2"
- 2 3/4" pieces of plywood ripped down to 14" x 12"
- 1 1/4" piece of plywood ripped down to 84" x 48"
- 2 1/4" pieces of plywood ripped down to 18 3/4" x 74 1/4"
- 4 lx4 @ 84 3/4"
- 4 lx4 @ 8 3/4"
- 4 lx4@77 l/4"
- 4 lx4 @ 15 3/4"
- 1 1x4 @ 76 3/4"
- 2 1x4 @ 46 1/2"
- 1 lx3 @ 50 l/2"
- 2 1x3 @ 16 5/8"
- 2 lx3@153/4"
- 2 lx3@83/4"
- 1 1x8 @ 46 1/2"
- 2 lx2 @ 84 3/4"
- 2 lx2@12"
- 2 1x2 @ 46 1/2"
