
## DIY MODERN OUTDOOR SIDE TABLE

1-1X4X8

1 - IX2 SCRAP PIECE 29" LONG

-4-2X2@18"


- 2 - 2X2 @ 15"

- 2 - 2X2 @ 12"


- 2 - IX2 (OR OTHER SCRAP MATERIAL) @ 14 1/2"

- 4 - IX4@12"


## STEP 1: ATTACH ONE 2X8 AND 2X2 TO THE LEGS AS SHOWN. YOU WILL USE POCKET HOLES DRILLED AT 1 1/2" AND 2 1/2" SCREWS. MAKE SURE AND USE WOOD GLUE ON ALL JOINTS IN THIS PROJECT.




STEP 2:
ADD SCRAP IX2 OR WHATEVER SCRAP WOOD YOU HAVE LAYING AROUND AS A SUPPORT TO ATTACH YOUR TABLE TOP TO LATER! MOVE THE BOARD DOWN 3/4" FROM THE TOP OF THE 2X8 AND BRAD NAIL (ALONG WITH GLUE OF COURSE) IT IN PLACE!




STEP 3: CREATE A SECOND SIDE REPEATING STEPS 1 AND 2.




STEP 4:
ATTACH THE TWO SIDES YOU BUILT TOGETHER WITH THE 2X8 AND 2X2 @ 12". THEY
WILL BE POCKET HOLED THE SAME AS PREVIOUS STEPS. (POCKET HOLES DRILLED AT 1
1/2" AND SCREWS OF 2 1/2")



STEP 5: ATTACH THE OPPOSITE SIDE.



STEP 6:
GLUE THE TOP BOARDS IN PLACE. YOU CAN USE BRAD NAILS BUT I JUST GLUED
THEM SO I DIDN'T HAVE TO FILL ANY HOLES!



STEP 7: SAND AND FINISH HOWEVER YOU WOULD LIKE!
