# DIY Dutch Door for Chicken Coop



#### Materials:


- -2 lx4xlO cedar boards
- -4 lx6x6 cedar fence pickets
- -l" wafer head screws
- -2 sets of 3" t-hinges
- -2 gate latches
- -Kreg jig
- -l l/4" Kreg screws
- -saw
- -wood glue

## **Cut List:**

- -4 lx4 @ 34 5/16"
- -4 lx4 @ 20 3/4"
- -12 1x6 fence pickets @ 27 3/4"


## Step 1:

Build the frame of the door. You will build 2 of the frames pictured below. You will drill pocket holes 3/4" deep and use 1 l/4" screws to attach. Make sure and use wood glue as well. Letters ph in the picture denotes where pocket holes will be drilled.




#### Step 2:

Using wood glue, screw lx6 fence pickets cut @ 27 3/4" directly onto the backside of the frame. The boards will cover the frame and be flush with the edges.



You can rip a board to cover that bottom space if you would like, I did not.

Here's the view from the front.



Add the hinges and gate latches to the door and then hang in door frame.
